Dear Olympian Guardian,

You are receiving this letter because your child did not complete an assignment or was not prepared for class. To ensure that the work is finished and to reinforce consequences of actions, he or she must serve a lunch detention during 5th period (lunch) on the same day of the infraction if received before lunch, or on the following day if received after lunch.

He or she needs to bring a lunch\* and the materials necessary to complete the assignment. If the assignment has already been completed before the lunch detention or your child is serving the detention for responsibility, then they may bring other homework or something to read; he or she is still required to attend in order to fulfill the consequences aspect of the program.

If your child is absent, he or she will still serve the lunch detention on the day he or she returns to school.

If your child does not complete the assignment in one session, he or she will be required to attend additional sessions until it is complete.

If your child earns more than one lunch detention for the same day, they will be served consecutively until each is satisfied.

Please be advised that this is not a study session. If a student needs additional help, we are available during advisory, before and after school, as well as during and between classes. We are glad to help, but the lunch detention is the opportunity to fulfill one's student responsibilities. Furthermore, students are expected to work and eat silently. Violations of these expectations will result in additional disciplinary consequences.

When the assignment is completed the student may submit it, however the assignment will be worth a maximum of 70% of its original value.
